Visiting the County office and need to know the accessible features of our building?



An **accessible parking** spot is available in the Huron Street parking lot, left hand side, beside the path into the building.



Our parking lot entrance and St. Andrew Street entrance are equipped with large **automatic door opener buttons**.

There are two **accessible washrooms** on the third level and a men's and ladies washroom with accessible stalls on the first level.

There is a **lift** available to access all three floors. Buzz the buzzer beside the lift or ask a nearby staff for assistance.
