

## SCHEDULE "A"

### THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PERTH (County by-law Number 2541)

#### REGULATIONS

The following regulations shall apply:

1. The length of signs shall not exceed 50 feet.
2. Signs shall not be more than 25 feet high measured from the ground.
3. The bottom of a sign shall not be less than 3 feet off the ground.
4. (a) Signs shall not be erected closer to the centreline of the County road allowance than is shown by the following schedule:

<u>Size of Sign</u>	<u>Minimum Distance from Centreline of County Road Allowance</u>
Less than 128 sq. feet	75 feet
128 sq. feet to 200 sq. feet	100 feet
201 sq. feet to 325 sq. feet	175 feet
326 sq. feet to 650 sq. feet	275 feet

- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of item 4(a), no sign shall be erected closer than 25 feet from the edge of the County road allowance.
5. Signs shall not be erected closer than 1,000 feet to each other.
6. Signs shall not be erected closer than 300 feet from the centre point of the intersection of roads or railways.
7. A sign shall not be erected at any point where a hazard would be created, or where conflict with traffic control devices might arise.
8. A sign shall not be erected at a point where it would obscure or adversely affect a desirable view from or adjacent to the County road allowance.
9. Signs shall not be painted upon, attached to or be made to form part of any fence, building, rock or other surface adjacent to the highways, except to advertise a business upon the property on which the advertisement is situated.
10. Signs shall not be illuminated except where provided for in the permit.
11. Signs shall be painted and kept in proper repair. If any sign or signs are not kept in proper repair, the owner shall repair, repaint or remove them within 30 days of having received a written request from the Corporation of the County of Perth.
12. Every sign shall show thereon the name of either the person or owner of the sign responsible for the erection and maintenance thereof in a clearly-visible position.
13. Any minor variances to Schedule "A" must have approval from the Public Works Department.
