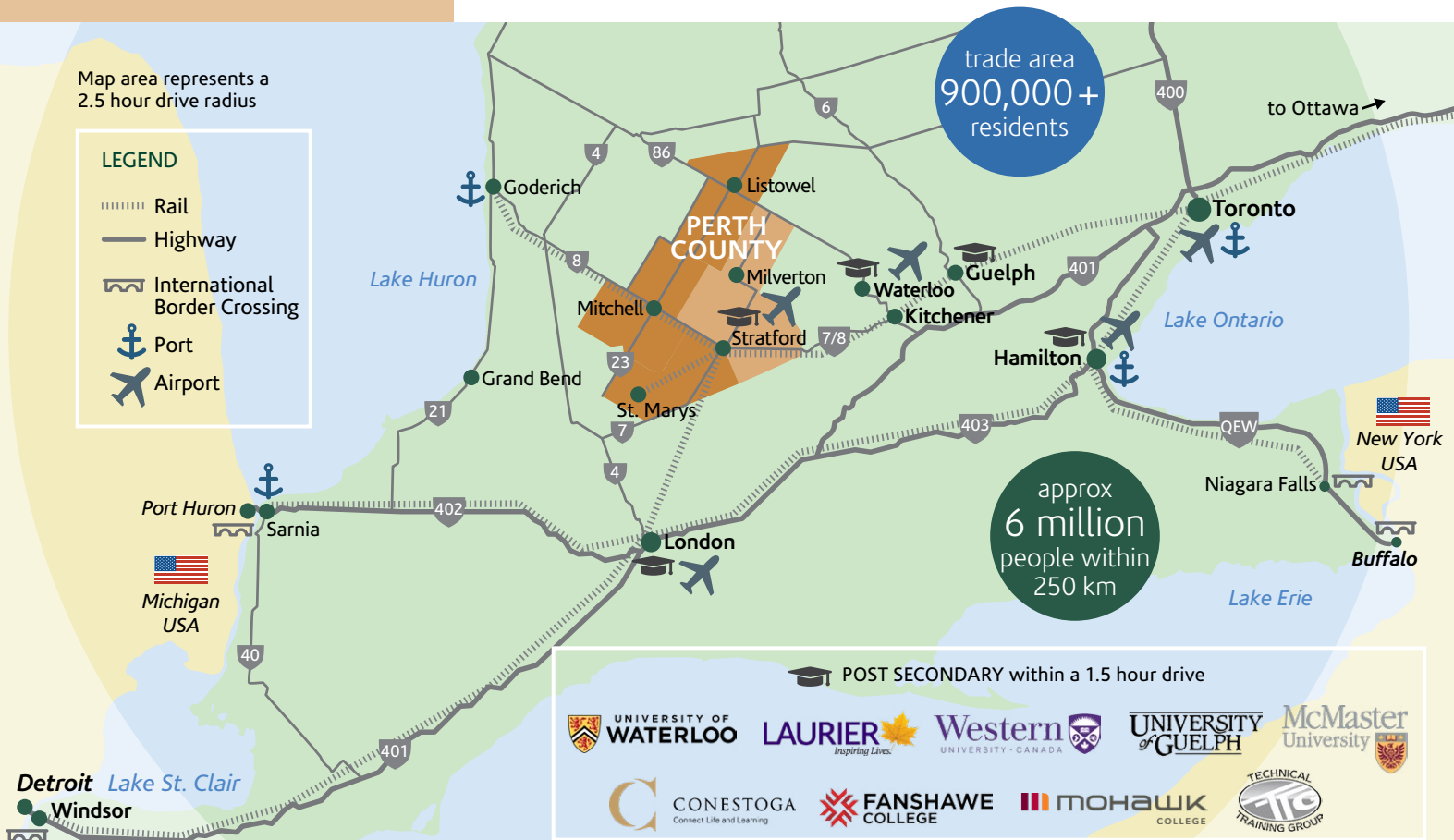

Perth East is a warm and welcoming place to call home, known for its unique Amish and Mennonite communities.

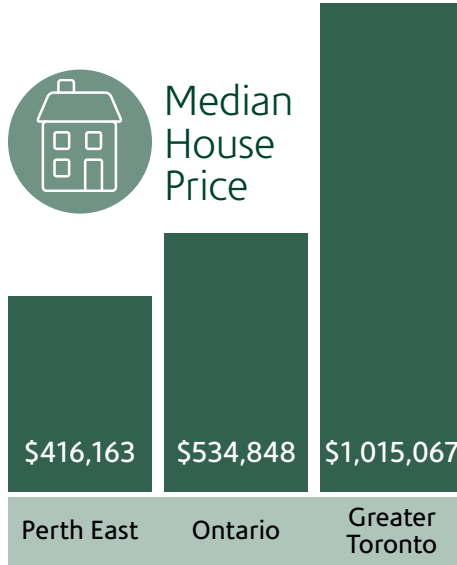
