As a teenager, **Thomas Edison** worked in the Grand Trunk Railway Station both in **Stratford** and the Junction Station in **St. Marys**.

St. Marys is home to the **Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame**, including a beautiful ball field set in a natural amphitheatre on the 32-acre property.

NHL Hockey-Hall-of-Famer **Howie Morenz** spent his formative years in **Mitchell**, just west of **Stratford**.

The **William Allman Arena (Stratford)** is the site of **Wayne Gretzky's** first minor hockey goal in 1968.

Former Canadian Prime Minister **Pierre Elliott Trudeau** was caught on film plunging from the high dive at Canada's largest spring-fed pool, the **St. Marys Quarry**. Let's here it for 'The Band...' legendary rock star **Richard Manuel** is buried in **Avondale Cemetery, Stratford**.

International pop star, **Justin Bieber** busked in front of the **Avon Theatre** hoping to raise enough money to take his mother to Disney World.

Did You Know?

Of the 125 **Carnegie** libraries in Canada, 111 were built in Ontario - five of which are in **Perth County**.

Milverton boasts the largest **Amish** settlement in Canada.

Built in 1885, **Stratford's Huron Street Bridge** is the only double-arched aqueduct road bridge in North America still in use.

Stratford Festival is the largest **repertory theatre** company in North America. Opened July 13, 1953.

Stratford has the most **parkland per capita** of any city in Canada.

Canada's 9th Prime Minister, **Arthur Meighen** is buried in **St. Marys**. The gardens at the **Stratford Festival** are named in his memory.

Perth County has over **200,000 hectares** of prime agricultural land and produces over **\$838 million** in cash farm receipts (Stats Canada)

Stratford is one of six **autonomous-vehicle** technology centres in Ontario.

Stratford has been recognized as a "smart city," with a focus on digital technology development in recent years.

The 110-kilometre **Avon Trail** travelling from **St. Marys** to **Conestogo** is available for year-round hiking, snow shoeing and skiing.

The **G2G** is a community based conversion of the former Canadian Pacific Railway right of way between **Goderich** & **Guelph**, offering over **127 km** of safe passage to hike, bike, run or walk.

Stratford's first pair of mute swans were a gift to the City in 1928. The annual **Swan Parade** in early April draws thousands to celebrate their return to the Avon.

The dramatic style of **Stratford's War Memorial** sculpted by **W.S. Allward**, was the precursor to the famed **Vimy Ridge Memorial** in France.
