Section 1: Stewart Family Tree

- Names and identification number of each descendant of Alexander Stewart [10] and Margaret *Ellis* Stewart [11] up to the 6th generation. Each new generation is indented. It should be noted that the tree is not complete. It contains only those members for which there is a photo or other documentation. The Stewart family emigrated from Scotland to Upper Canada in the early half of the 19th century.

Note on Organization of the Family Tree:

1. Each person has been designated a number which correlates to their position on the family tree. The first two identified members of the family are each given a number. Each consecutive child is then given a letter to the end of that number. For example, the first child is 1-2a, the second child is 1-2b, and so on. The numbering system continues with each new generation being given an additional letter signifying their position within the tree.
2. Each spouse of a direct descendant is designated with Sp. for Spouse. For example, if they are married to the third child in the family tree, they would be numbered as, "1-2c.Sp." If they have more than more spouse, it will be denoted by a number after the Sp. "1-2c.Sp.2."

If an individual in this family tree is connected to another family associated with the project, that person's identification number will change in their second tree.

The number of children born to Alexander Stewart and Margaret Ellis and the order of their birth is uncertain. The information presented below may need to be corrected and updated.

The spelling of the surname varied between Stewart and Stuart. Originally, the name was spelled as Stewart. At some point, however, the spelling of the name among Samuel Stewart's family began to shift. It was a generally accepted story among the grandchildren that Henrietta's daughters (Pearl Casemore is given the most credit for this) believed that Stewart, which was an Irish spelling, was "common" and that Stuart (i.e., which they believed was Scottish) was a better-class of spelling. Thus, the spelling changed.

Rohmer's Exxoneration worse than Ultimatum

EXXONERATION by Richard Rohmer (McClelland and Stewart Ltd.—\$8.95)

In Canada, Richard Rohmer's *Ultimatum* was a best seller. It was a shallow work of literary exploitation, capitalizing on both the energy crisis and an adult population that seems more interested in the trendy than the substantive.

It was a book that did lip service to the genre of Allen Drury, a talented exponent of the art of transforming today's politics and history into instant novels.

Rohmer has adapted the Drury technique but the end product is like a high school art student's brassy efforts to out-cube Picasso.

Still, you can't knock success. And Rohmer obviously decided to capitalize on *Ultimatum* with a follow-up novel—well, that's what they call it on the jacket at least—called *Exxoneration*.

It picks up where the other one left off with Canada about to be strong-armed into colonization by an energy-hungry U.S.

It is, to be candid, worse even than *Ultimatum*.

The leading players are caricatures, the kind of fleshless super-slicks who populate too many contemporary novels already.

They leave the impression they were dumped off an assembly line and sold in do-it-yourself kits to would-be authors.

The plot line is about as credible as a soap commercial.

Canada out-bluffs the U.S. in what amounts to the Stanley Cup of war games and sends them air-lifting home to sulk (you didn't really think the good guys could lose did you?) then launches an economic counterattack.

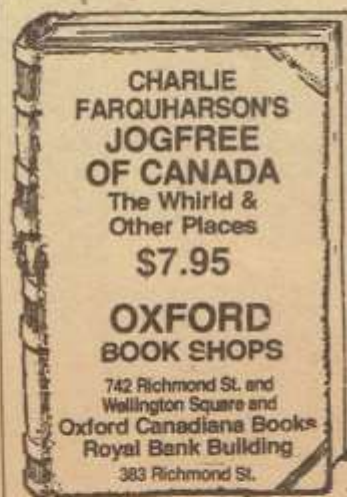
With Col. Pierre Thomas de Gaspé (his daddy was a well-to-do Montreal lawyer from an elite Quebec family, his mommy a "delicate but strong-willed" representative of a wealthy London (Ontario) family) plotting the manoeuvres, Canada attempts to take over Exxon, the huge U.S. oil company and source, of course, of that painfully cute title.

It would be unfair to reveal how it all turns out. Even if it is terribly predictable.

Rohmer may well have another best seller on his hands if only because it touches on that peculiar love-hate fascination Canadians have for things American.

He tickles our day dreams, even if he does it with a minimum of style and depth.

Hops Yeast.

Gather hops + dry. Store in cotton bags. when dry. To make yeast. add 2 good handfuls hops to 3 quarts boiling water, allow to boil 20 minutes, strain.

To the liquid strained from the hops add 3 cups flour $\frac{3}{4}$ cup Brown sugar $\frac{3}{4}$ cup salt. heat until smooth. When cool put in $\frac{1}{2}$ cup yeast. (This yeast $\frac{1}{2}$ cup would be taken from a jar that had been stored previously)

Next morning.

Boil 6 large potatoes. Drain + mash. Then add 1 cup of the water drained from the potatoes. When cool put in the yeast you made yesterday + heat. Let it stand for 3 days. Put in jars + set in the cellar. It will be ready for next week.

If you intend to bake Friday make your yeast Wed. afternoon.
